In part 1 of the exam you will be given five short answer questions. Please choose and answer **ANY FOUR** (4x15 = 60 points). Word limit – max 175 words.

- 1. Take a look at the example of the t-shirt and globalization that was discussed in lecture: What does it tell us about globalization? Give two examples from the video to illustrate your point.
- 2. According to Rhacel Parennas the experience of time-space compression is unequal. It is mediated by class and gender among families of Filipina migrant workers. Explain how the experience of time-space compression is mediated by class and by gender among the families of Filipina migrant workers. Give one example of each.
- 3. What is the chain of care paradigm? How does the film Paper Dolls challenge this paradigm/way of thinking about gender and migration?
- 4. We have learned that kinship is constructed through descent and marriage. But there are other ways in which kinship can be constructed. Can you list and explain two more ways in which kinship is constructed?
- 5. What is the difference between ethnocentrism and cultural relativism? According to Lila Abu Lughod, cultural relativism has its limits. How do we overcome these limits?

- 6. What is the difference between colonialism and settler colonialism? As discussed in lecture, anthropologist Patrick Wolfe tells us that the settler logic of elimination is based on land and not race. Explain with an example.
- 7. What is cultural imperialism? What are 3 anthropological critiques of cultural imperialism? Explain with one example for each.
